Report:

The work involved a cutting for a new swimming pool located on the line of the moat to the east of the house. The pool dimensions are 13.76m x 6.76m, with a 1.5m fall from the shallow to the deepest point, which lies at the southern end of the cutting. Approximately two-thirds of the new pool lies on the site of a large c.19th century rectangular pool or tank, constructed of cement-rendered red brick. The brickwork on three sides of the earlier pool had been removed, leaving the southern side, which is to stay in place. To the west side, a fresh cutting exposed a small soil section which is included on Figure 2.

There is to be some deeper excavation in the central part of the southern end. However, a second visit was not felt to be justified in view of the extent of earlier ground disturbance.
